☐ Ephesus was also the home of the goddess,
called Diana by the Romans. Her temple wasx the
size of the Parthenon in Athens and was lauded as one of
the seven of the world.
The first time we are introduced to Ephesus in Scripture is
in Acts 18. Toward the end of his missionary
journey, Paul visited Ephesus with Priscilla and Aquila,
whom he met during his stay at Corinth. It was during this
time that came to Ephesus and ministered
there alongside Priscilla and Aquila. Paul returned to Ephe-
sus on his third missionary journey, probably around 52AD
and stayed there for nearly years, ministering to the
saints.
IPaul wrote this epistle to the Ephesians roughly 5-7 years
later while imprisoned in, along with Colossians,
Philemon, and Philippians, which are commonly called the
epistles.
The word saints simply means "". In
Scripture, to be holy is to be by God for his
holy and good purposes.
