## The Crowning Moment of Christ's Saving Work

 $1Jn\ 3$  For this purpose the Son of God was manifested, that He might destroy the works of the devil.

Rom 14 <sup>9</sup>To this end Christ died and rose and lived again, that He might be Lord of both the dead and the living.

► The modern church typically doesn't celebrate Christ's		
ascension, but the early church celebrated it long before the		
celebrated His, for they regarded Christ's		
ascension as the crowning moment of his saving work, and		
that indeed is how Scripture presents it. Christ's ascension		
marked his coronation as of kings. Christ's		
ascension is what Daniel saw in his vision.		

Dn 7 <sup>13</sup> "I was watching in the night visions, and behold, One like the Son of Man, coming with the clouds of heaven! He came to the Ancient of Days, and they brought Him near before Him. <sup>14</sup> Then to Him was given dominion and glory and a kingdom, that all peoples, nations, and languages should serve Him. His dominion is an everlasting dominion, which shall not pass away, and His kingdom the one which shall not be destroyed."

This is why John, in his opening greeting of Revelation, referred to Jesus as "the \_\_\_\_\_ over the kings of the earth." And Heb 12 says Jesus is shaking the nations until what remains is the only thing that cannot be shaken – the kingdom of God.

Rev 1 <sup>4</sup> John, to the seven churches which are in Asia: Grace to you and peace from Him who is and who was and who is to come, and from the seven Spirits who are before His throne, <sup>5</sup> and from Jesus Christ, the faithful witness, the firstborn from the dead, and the ruler over the kings of the earth.
