He shall bear their iniquities. Heb 9.28 Christ was offered once to bear the sins of many * When you think of propitiation, think of ... Heb 13.11 For the bodies of those animals whose blood is brought into the sanctuary by the high priest for sin, are * Hebrews 9.5 calls the "mercy seat" the ... burned outside the camp. 12 Therefore Jesus also, that He might sanctify the people with His own blood, suffered outside the camp. * What was the Day of Atonement about? Psalm 103.12 As far as the east is from the west, so far has He removed our transgressions from us. * To be "clean" meant two things ... Psalm 51.7 Purge me with hyssop, and I shall be clean; * The sin offering on the day of atonement gives us ... wash me, and I shall be whiter than snow. * What 3 things were required for a sin offering animal? Heb 10.4 It [was] not possible [for] the blood of bulls and goats [to] take away sins 5 Consequently, when Christ came into the world, He said "Sacrifices and offerings You have not desired, but a body You have prepared for Me ... 7 ... Behold, I have come to do your will, O God" 10 And by that will we have been sanctified through the offering of * What animal was used on the day of atonement, and how? the body of Jesus Christ once for all.

* How did Jesus fulfill that picture?

Isa 53.2 He shall grow up before Him as a tender plant, and as a root out of dry ground.

Isa 53.2 [W]hen we see Him, there is no beauty that we should desire Him. John 1.14 [W]e beheld His glory, the glory as of the only begotten of the Father, full of grace and truth.

Rom 5.8 But God demonstrates His own love toward us, in that while we were still sinners, Christ died for us. 9 Much more then, having now been justified by His blood, we shall be saved from wrath through Him. 10 For if when we were enemies we were reconciled to God through the death of His Son, much more, having been reconciled, we shall be saved by His life. 11 And not only that, but we also rejoice in God through our Lord Jesus Christ, through

whom we have now received the reconciliation.
