“**Sit at My Right Hand**” – 1

Psalm 110 A Psalm of David. 1 The LORD said to my Lord, “Sit at My right hand, Till I make Your enemies Your footstool.” 2 The LORD shall send the rod of Your strength out of Zion. Rule in the midst of Your enemies! 3 Your people shall be volunteers In the day of Your power; In the beauties of holiness, from the womb of the morning, You have the dew of Your youth. 4 The LORD has sworn And will not relent, “You are a priest forever According to the order of Melchizedek.” 5 The Lord is at Your right hand; He shall execute kings in the day of His wrath. 6 He shall judge among the nations, He shall fill the places with dead bodies, He shall execute the heads of many countries. 7 He shall drink of the brook by the wayside; Therefore He shall lift up the head.

* Psalm 110, like Psalm 2, is one of the most ...

* Psalm 110 is a psalm of ..., who was one of the main ... And like many of the psalms, it had a typological ... in the life of ...

* David clearly understood that the ultimate reality of this psalm would be ...

* Vs 1: What is meant by “LORD” and “Lord”?

Mat 22.41 While the Pharisees were gathered together, Jesus asked them, 42 saying, “What do you think about the Christ? Whose Son is He?” They said to Him, “The Son of David.” 43 He said to them, “How then does David in the Spirit call Him ‘Lord,’ saying: 44 ‘The LORD said to my Lord, “Sit at My right hand, Till I make Your enemies Your footstool” ’? 45 If David then calls Him ‘Lord,’ how is He his Son?” 46 And no one was able to answer Him a word, nor from that day on did anyone dare question Him anymore.

Isaiah 11.1 “There shall come forth a Rod from the stem of Jesse, and a Branch shall grow out of his roots ... 10 And in that day there shall be a Root of Jesse, who shall stand as a banner to the people.”

Rev 22.16 “I am the root and the offspring of David.”

These verses only make sense if ...

* Vs 2: The Son is not ... while the Father does the work; the Son is ...

* What does it mean for the Son’s enemies to be made his footstool? What was the Ark of the Covenant and the Mercy Seat? Where was God said to be enthroned? What was the Mercy Seat also called?

Lev 16.15 “Then he shall kill the goat of the sin offering, which is for the people, bring its blood inside the veil, do with that blood as he did with the blood of the bull, and sprinkle it on the mercy seat and before the mercy seat.”

Exo 25.22 “And there I will meet with you, and I will speak with you from above the mercy seat, from between the two cherubim which are on the ark of the Testimony ...

1Chron 28.2 Then King David rose to his feet and said, “Hear me, my brethren and my people: I had it in my heart to build a house of rest for the ark of the covenant of the LORD, and for the footstool of our God ...

* The Holiest of Holies was typological model of ...

Isaiah 66.1 Thus says the LORD: “Heaven is My throne, And earth is My footstool. Where is the house that you will build Me? And where is the place of My rest?

Mat 5.34 “But I say to you, do not swear at all: neither by heaven, for it is God’s throne; 35 nor by the earth, for it is His footstool; nor by Jerusalem, for

it is the city of the great King.”

1Kings 8.27 “But will God indeed dwell on the earth? Behold, heaven and the heaven of heavens cannot contain You. How much less this temple which I have built!”

* Where were the people called to worship God?

Psalm 132.7 Let us go into His tabernacle; Let us worship at His footstool.

* God’s people are even called his ...

Lamentations 2.1 How the Lord has covered the daughter of Zion With a cloud in His anger! He cast down from heaven to the earth The beauty of Israel, And did not remember His footstool In the day of His anger.

* Vs 4: The next thing we need to note about Psalm 110 is that there is a ...

* The Aaronic priesthood had to be ... because Aaron and all his sons ... The sacrifices they presented had to be..., for the blood of bulls and goats ... The sacrifices were all ...

Heb 10.1 For the Law, since it has only a shadow of the good things to come and not the very image of things, can never, by the same sacrifices which they offer continually year by year, make perfect those who draw near ... 4 For it is impossible for the blood of bulls and goats to take away sins.

* Who is Melchizedek? What did Melchizedek and Abraham give to one another? What is the significance of that?

* Melchizedek means ..., and Gn 14 and Hb 7 tell us he was ..., which means ...

* Vs 4: A “priest forever according to the order of Melchizedek” means ...

* The main question we are left with is ...

* How do the following texts answer that question?

Acts 2:29 "Men and brethren, let me speak freely to you of the patriarch David, that he is both dead and buried, and his tomb is with us to this day. 30 Therefore, being a prophet, and knowing that God had sworn with an oath to him that of the fruit of his body, according to the flesh, He would raise up the Christ to sit on his throne, 31 he, foreseeing this, spoke concerning the resurrection of the Christ, that His soul was not left in Hades, nor did His flesh see corruption. 32 This Jesus God has raised up, of which we are all witnesses. 33 Therefore being exalted to the right hand of God, and having received from the Father the promise of the Holy Spirit, He poured out this which you now see and hear. 34 For David did not ascend into the heavens, but he says himself: 'The LORD said to my Lord, "Sit at My right hand, 35 Till I make Your enemies Your footstool." ' 36 Therefore let all the house of Israel know assuredly that God has made this Jesus, whom you crucified, both Lord and Christ."

Heb 5:5 So also Christ did not glorify Himself to become High Priest, but it was He who said to Him: "You are My Son, Today I have begotten You." 6 As He also says in another place: "You are a priest forever According to the order of Melchizedek" ... 9 And having been perfected, He became the author of eternal salvation to all who obey Him, 10 called by God as High Priest "according to the order of Melchizedek,"
