Psalm 115.8 Those who make [idols] are like them; So is everyone who trusts in them.

2Cor 3.18 But we all, with unveiled face, beholding as in a mirror the glory of the Lord, are being transformed into the same image from glory to glory, just as by the Spirit of the Lord.

Phil 4.8 [W]hatever things are true, ... noble, ... just, ... pure, ... lovely, ... of good report, if there is any <u>virtue</u> and ... anything praiseworthy — meditate on these things.

Rom 11.36 For off Him and through Him and to Him are all things, to whom be glory forever. Amen.

Mat 22.37 Jesus said to him, "'You shall love the LORD your God with all your heart, with all your soul, and with all your mind.' 38 This is the first and great commandment. 39 And the second is like it: 'You shall love your neighbor as yourself.' 40 On these two commandments hang all the Law and the Prophets."

2Pet 1.3 His divine power has given to us all things that pertain to life and godliness, through the knowledge of Him who called us by glory and virtue, 4 ... that ... you may be partakers of the divine nature, having escaped the corruption that is in the world through lust. 5 ... [F]or this very reason, giving all diligence, add to your faith virtue, to virtue knowledge, 6 ... self-control, ... perseverance, ... godliness, 7 ... brotherly kindness, ... and ... love. 8 For if these things are yours and abound, you will be neither useless nor unfruitful in the knowledge of our Lord Jesus Christ. 9 For he who lacks these things is shortsighted, even to blindness, and has forgotten that he was cleansed from his old sins.

Mat 23.5 But all their works they do to be seen by men ... 6 They love the best places at feasts, the best seats in the synagogues, 7 greetings in the marketplaces, and to be called by men, 'Rabbi,' Rabbi.'
