Inheriting the Promises 2

Gal 3 ¹ O foolish Galatians! Who has bewitched you that you should not obey the truth, before whose eyes Jesus Christ was clearly portrayed among you as crucified? 2 This only I want to learn from vou: Did vou receive the Spirit by the works of the law, or by the hearing of faith? ... 6 Just as Abraham "believed God, and it was accounted to him for righteousness." ⁷ Therefore know that only those who are of faith are sons of Abraham. 8 And the Scripture, foreseeing that God would justify the Gentiles by faith, preached the gospel to Abraham beforehand, saying, "In you all the nations shall be blessed." ⁹ So then those who are of faith are blessed with believing Abraham ... ¹⁵ Brethren, I speak in the manner of men: Though it is only a man's covenant, yet if it is confirmed, no one annuls or adds to it. 16 Now to Abraham and his Seed were the promises made. He does not say, "And to seeds," as of many, but as of one, "And to your Seed," who is Christ. 17 And this I say, that the law, which was four hundred and thirty years later, cannot annul the covenant that was confirmed before by God in Christ, that it should make the promise of no effect. ¹⁸ For if the inheritance is of the law, it is no longer of promise; but God gave it to Abraham by promise.

Gn 15 ¹ After these things the word of the LORD came unto Abram in a vision, saying, "Fear not, Abram: I am thy shield, and thy exceeding great reward."

Jn 8 ⁵⁶ "Your father Abraham rejoiced to see My day, and he saw it and was glad." ⁵⁷ Then the Jews said to Him, "You are not yet fifty years old, and have You seen Abraham?" ⁵⁸ Jesus said to them, "Most assuredly, I say to you, before Abraham was, I AM." Gn15 ³ And Abram said, "Behold, to me thou hast given no seed: and, lo, one born in my house is mine heir." ⁴ And, behold, the word of the LORD came unto him, saying, This shall not be thine heir; but he that shall come forth out of thine own bowels shall be thine heir. ⁵ And he brought him forth abroad, and said, Look now toward heaven, and tell the stars, if thou be able to number them: and he said unto him, So shall thy seed be. ⁶ And he believed in the LORD; and he counted it to him for righteousness.

▶ Is Christ simply reiterating the promise of Gn13.16?

Gn 13 ¹⁶ "I will make your seed as the dust of the earth; so that if a man could <u>number</u> [manah] the dust of the earth, then your seed also could be <u>numbered</u> [manah]."

Gn 15 ⁵ "Look now toward heaven, and <u>tell</u> [saphar] the stars, if thou be able to <u>number</u> [saphar] them": and he said unto him, "So shall thy seed be."

Ps 19 ¹ The heavens <u>declare</u> [saphar] the glory of God; And the firmament shows His handiwork.

Ps 48 ¹² Walk about Zion, and go all around her. <u>Count</u> [saphar] her towers; ¹³ Mark well her bulwarks; Consider her palaces; That you may <u>tell</u> [saphar] it to the generation following.

What story do the stars tell?

Rm 10 ⁹ [I]f you confess with your mouth the Lord Jesus and believe in your heart that God has raised Him from the dead, you will be saved. ¹⁰ For with the heart one believes unto righteousness, and with the mouth confession is made unto salvation ... ¹⁴ How then shall they ... believe in Him of whom they have not heard? And how shall they hear without a preacher? ¹⁵ And how shall they preach unless they are sent? ... ¹⁸ But I say, have they not heard? Yes indeed: "Their sound has gone out to all the earth, and their words to the ends of the world." (cf. Ps 19.4)

Psalm 19 ¹ The heavens <u>declare</u> [saphar] the glory of God; And the firmament shows His handiwork. ² Day unto day utters speech, and night unto night reveals knowledge. ³ There is no speech nor language where their voice is not heard. ⁴ Their line has gone out through all the earth, and their words to the end of the world. In them He has set a tabernacle for the sun, ⁵ which is like a bridegroom coming out of his chamber, and rejoices like a strong man to run its race. ⁶ Its rising is from one end of heaven, and its circuit to the other end; And there is nothing hidden from its heat.
